SICARIUS COMMENTARY

Halcyon Advisory Group enters this reporting period with a fully resolved findings register and demonstrated security controls across all four pillars. Four findings were identified and resolved during the monitoring period — none remain open. The mean time to resolution was 11 days, reflecting strong coordination between the Security Lead, Director, and Technical Coordinator. Staff training is complete across all 13 employees, with 100% completion across all 12 modules. The Director has signed all 16 baseline policies. Beacon continuous monitoring is active across endpoint protection, identity security, credential exposure, and patch compliance. No active threats or incidents have been detected. This is a strong security posture for an organisation of this size and profile.
